

## Town Center / RiverPark Neighborhood

On October 21, 2008 the Oxnard City Council approved Resolution 13,562 which allows police to conduct traffic enforcement in the Town Center / RiverPark Neighborhood.

### Top 5 Causes of Traffic Collisions Fine:

1. Traveling at an unsafe speed.....\$266.00
2. Following too close.....\$146.00
3. Unsafe lane changes.....\$146.00
4. Fail to yield the right of way.....\$146.00
5. Running red lights.....\$380.00

### What You Can Do:

Drive the speed limit. Driving the speed limit allows you the necessary time to react to an emergency situation and decreases your chance of getting a ticket.

Let aggressive drivers pass you. Don't allow other drivers dictate how you drive.

Slow down during bad weather. Driving slower than the speed limit on rainy days or days with poor visibility.

Leave early. Make sure you have plenty of time to get to your destination so you don't feel pressured to speed or disobey traffic signals.

Don't tailgate other vehicles. Allow more distance between you and the vehicle ahead of you. This will give you more time to react to an emergency situation and it increases your stopping distance.

- 5204(a) CVC  
Improper registration tabs displayed.....\$76.00
- 8-42(B) OXO  
Inoperative vehicle on street.....\$65.00
- 8-45(A) OXO  
Key in vehicle with motor running.....\$65.00
- 8-50 OXO  
Alley parking.....\$40.00
- 8-54 OXO  
Red zone parking.....\$40.00
- 8-55 OXO  
Fire hydrant.....\$65.00
